WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Vintage 2008 produced a wine of classic proportions and full purple-black color. The intense and complex nose evokes dusty blackberry, licorice, cocoa, spices and maraschino cherry. The palate is full of sweet black fruits, with lovely fresh cracked nut and a cherry chocolate cake tilt. Substantial but balanced tannins underlay the fruit, and lead to a lengthy finish. Aged in French Oak approximately 40% new. Just a beautiful example of the attractive qualities of Washington Cabernet from Old Vines on a great site. Of proven ageability, this should last well for 10-15 years in the cellar.
