WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Full purple-red color. Nose of blackcurrants, subtle dried herbs, hint of vanillin and a quiet dusty black pepper note. The palate shows lush black fruits over polished tannins, leading to a balanced slightly drying fruit finish. Aged exclusively in French Oak, approximately 40% new. A classic vintage exhibiting true Seven Hills Vineyard terroir from vines nearly three decades in age. I expect a delightful cellar life of 8-12 years.
