



## 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon, RESERVE, Walla Walla Valley

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Vineyards: Seven Hills Vineyard, Fire Ridge Vineyard

Grapes: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vintage: Cool growing season, moderate autumn with extended ripening period, Very low yields

Ageing: 30 Months in French Oak Barrels Vicard and Taransaud, 50% new

Aroma: blackberries, black cherries, mulberry, incense

Taste: concentrated dark plum, dark chocolate, licorice

Vegan: Yes

Alcohol: 14.4%

Lot size: 82 cases

### Winemaker's Notes

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This is our ninth *Reserve* Cabernet Sauvignon, sourced from the old vines at Seven Hills Vineyard and the stunning Fire Ridge Vineyard of the Walla Walla Valley. Deep purple in color with complex aromas of black plums, Christmas fruitcake, rawhide and burned incense. Intense, concentrated, dark fruit flavors: black currant, blackberries, mulberry, and chambord layered with licorice, coffee, birch bark and sasparilla. Firmly elegant, with intense tannin structure deftly integrated with the dense core of substantial fruit providing a massive wine that lingers for minutes through a rich and spicy finish.
